Nonresident Elk, Deer and Combination Licenses are obtained directly from Montana Fish Wildlife & Parks (406) 444-2950 www.fwp.mt.gov before March 15th. Purchasing an area 313-45 special elk permit before March 15th is also necessary to hunt elk in this area. Client & MGS agree to abide by the laws of the state of Montana. Montana law governs this agreement.

Client acknowledges they will be hunting in the habitat of wolves, bears, mountain lions, etc. and assumes the inherent risks involved in hunting big game in Montana's wild lands. MGS recommends our clients carry "Bear Spray" as a safety precaution. This is a "fair chase" hunt and there is no guarantee the client will harvest an animal. Our guides will field dress, prepare harvested game and deliver it to local taxidermists and meat processors at clients' request. Gratuities are not included in the hunt price and deposits are nonrefundable.

Client will make MGS aware of any special medical conditions or dietary requirements before arrival in Gardiner, Montana.
